

GHAMRO - NOTICE TO MUSIC USERS

The Ghana Music Rights Organization (GHAMRO) is the music collective management society duly registered under the Companies Act, 1963 (Act 179) and established under the Copyright Act 2005 Act 690. GHAMRO further approved by the Ministry of Justice and Attorney-Generals' Department to license, collect and distribute royalties to music right holders is regulated by the Copyright Regulation 2010, Legislative Instrument (L.I), 1962

The Society wishes to inform all establishments/public places such as radio & television stations, hotels, restaurants, night clubs, and other public places that use/perform musical works and sound recordings, that it is embarking on a national enforcement exercise to retrieve all outstanding copyright royalty fees.

Music users are to take note that apart from the National Spinners Association (NSA) the Society has **not signed any Agreement or negotiated** the payment of copyright royalties with any other Association. Individual establishments/public place are solely liable for the payment of copyright fees.

All individual music users are hereby advised to contact GHAMRO to settle their indebtedness accordingly.
